**Instrument (provided by parents):**

- This instrument is supplied by the school.
- Students and parents assume all responsibility for care and maintenance of the bassoon, including repair costs
- The bassoon comes with an instrument part called the bocal – it is imperative that students take good care of this part of the instrument. Any damage to the bocal will require you to replace it.
- There will be a \$100 rental fee for checking out an instrument from the school

**Required Book (provided by parents):**

- Foundations for Superior Performance, for BASSOON

**Required Accessories (provided by parents):**

- 3 reeds from director or lesson teacher (when the school year begins)
- Bassoon reed case (must hold at least 3 reeds)
- SILK bassoon swab
- 1 tube of cork grease
- Soaker cup and music stand clip
- Tonal Energy App on phone
- Wire Music Stand (for at home practice) / lyre and flip folder (for marching season)

**Things that students need to keep track of all music given (provided by parents):**

- Black 1 inch binder
- 10 page protectors
- Pencil bags
- Pencil
- Highlighter

**Student will need all of the above items the first week of summer band and for their daily grades throughout the year!**

**Please do not purchase your instrument/accessories at a different store without talking to a band director first.**

**Private Lessons:**

- It is REQUIRED that students wishing to play the bassoon enroll in lessons with our bassoon private instructor
- Lessons take place on a weekly basis for a reasonable fee (similar to what it would cost if the student were renting his or her own instrument)
- The private lesson teacher provides individualized instruction on the instrument and can make reeds for the student that is far superior quality to those offered in the music store.
- Lessons should start in the summer before school begins. Please contact Ms. Campos, Mr. Simpson or Mr. Maldonado for information about lessons as soon as possible.
