Instrument (provided by parents):

- The School provides you with all instruments needed in percussion
- You must purchase your own sticks/mallets
- You must purchase a stick bag
- There will be a \$100 user fee for the use of all concert and marching percussion equipment

Required Book (provided by parents):

- Foundations for Superior Performance, for Snare and Mallets (2 Books)

Required Accessories (provided by parents):

- American Custom 13 staccato timpani mallets; SD1 General Sticks; FPR2 Marching Snare sticks; Tenor sticks; Bass Drum sticks; bell/xylo mallets; Marimba mallets (depending on your audition for fall)
- Tonal Energy App on phone
- Wire Music Stand (for at home practice) / lyre and flip folder (for marching season)
- Students will be required to replace broken sticks as needed

Provided by Crockett Band Program:

- Black 1 inch binder
- 10 page protectors
- Pencil bags
- Pencil
- Highlighter

Student will need all of the above items the first week of summer band and for their daily grades throughout the year!

If you have questions about an accessory that is NOT on this list please contact your band director to make sure that you are purchasing a quality accessory.

If you have an instrument/accessories already:

Please bring them by the school so that one of the band directors can inspect them. Some instruments/accessories need a great deal of repair before they are playable, and some instruments/accessories are not suitable for beginners.

Private Lessons:

- It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that students wishing to play Percussion enroll in lessons with our Percussion lesson teacher.
- Lessons take place on a weekly basis for a reasonable fee (similar to what it would cost if the student were renting his or her own instrument)
- The private teacher provides individualized instruction on the instrument
- Lessons should start in the summer before school begins. Please contact Ms. Campos, Mr. Fair or Mr. Simpson for information about lessons as soon as possible.
