Instrument (provided by parents):

- These instruments are supplied by the school.
- Students and parents assume all responsibility for care and maintenance of the euphonium (baritone), including repair costs.
- Schilke 51D Mouthpiece
- There will be a \$100 rental fee for checking out the concert and marching instruments from the school

Required Book (provide by parents):

- Foundation for Superior Performance, for Euphonium B.C.

Required Accessories (provided by parents):

- 1 bottle of valve oil (Al Cass or Blue juice)
- Tonal Energy App on phone
- Wire Music Stand (for at home practice) / lyre and flip folder (for marching season)

Things that students need to keep track of all music given (provided by parents):

- Black 1 inch binder
- 10 page protectors
- Pencil bags
- Pencil
- Highlighter

Student will need all of the above items the first week of summer band and for their daily grades throughout the year!

Private Lessons:

It is strongly suggested that students wishing to play the baritone enroll in lessons with a qualified private instructor. Lessons take place on a weekly basis for a reasonable fee (similar to what it would cost if the students were renting his or her own instrument). Mr. Castro, Mr. Avila and I will be providing information on private lessons to all beginning baritone students.

Private Lessons:

- It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that students wishing to play the Euphonium enroll in lessons with our Euphonium lesson teacher.
- Lessons take place on a weekly basis for a reasonable fee (similar to what it would cost if the student were renting his or her own instrument)
- The private teacher provides individualized instruction on the instrument
- Lessons should start in the summer before school begins. Please contact Ms. Campos, Mr. Simpson or Mr. Maldonado for information about lessons as soon as possible.
