Instrument (provided by parents):

- This instrument is supplied by the school.
- Students and parents assume all responsibility for care and maintenance of the oboe, including repair costs
- The oboe is a very fragile instrument and must be taken care of at all times.
- There will be a \$100 rental fee for checking out an instrument from the school

Required Book(provided by parents):

- Foundations for Superior Performance, for OBOE

Required Accessories (provided by parents):

- 3 reeds from director or lesson teacher (when the school year begins)
- Oboe reed case (must hold at least 3 reeds)
- SILK oboe swab
- Soaker cup and music stand clip
- 1 tube of cork grease
- Wire Music Stand (for at home practice) / lyre and flip folder (for marching season)
- Tonal Energy app on phone

Provided by Crockett Band Program:

- Black 1 inch binder
- 10 page protectors
- Pencil bags
- Pencil
- Highlighter

Student will need all of the above items the first week of summer band and for their daily grades throughout the year!

Please do not purchase your instrument/accessories at a different store without talking to a band director first.

Private Lessons:

- It is REQUIRED that students wishing to play the oboe enroll in lessons with our oboe private instructor
- Lessons take place on a weekly basis for a reasonable fee (similar to what it would cost if the student were renting his or her own instrument)
- The private lesson teacher provides individualized instruction on the instrument and can make reeds for the student that is far superior quality to those offered in the music store.
